PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Students studying either Diploma of Building Design; or Diploma of Interior Design and Decoration have the opportunity to travel to Denmark to participate in workshops and classes at VIA College University. Students will immerse with domestic and international students studying Architectural Technology and Construction Management and collaborate in class projects and attend lectures. Students will immerse themselves in Danish design and visit some of the world's most well-known and influential buildings and interiors. Students will also visit industry as well as significant

landmarks. Past students say this tour is amazing. They gained a broadened understanding of design, found new ways of thinking in design and made new friends. They all said they would encourage other students to take the opportunity.

PROGRAM INCLUSION

Program cost includes:

- Return flights
- Twin share accommodation (including breakfast)
- Comprehensive travel insurance
- Tuition and material fees for master classes
- Airport transfers
- Contribution to study tour leader costs
- \$250 non-refundable administration fee

Program exclusions:

- Passport costs ensuring 6 months validity upon return of travel
- Visa application
- Meals outside of workshops and accommodation
- Some sightseeing expenses
